Camp Quest will operate its own program with its own counselors--the 4-H staff will support us with lifeguards, staff at the riding stables, food service, & etc. This campsite is located minutes from US-131, about halfway between Kalamazoo and Saugatuck.

Through our host camp, campers will enjoy the beach, activity fields, challenge courses, horseback riding, basketball, boating (canoes, kayaks), climbing tower, and archery range. Our Camp Quest staff will supervise activities that may include a variety of interests such as arts and crafts, nature study, astronomy, evolution, history, literature, famous freethinkers, and critical thinking challenges. We may have special guests to make this an event to remember for years to come. We are pleased to provide a high staff-to-camper ratio (1:2) to maximize camper fun.

The standard registration fee for 2009 is \$550 per camper . A discount rate of \$475 for early registration extends through April 30, 2009 – with additional discounts for siblings. Interested parents are encouraged to take advantage of a camp experience that combines reason, science, and critical inquiry with traditional camp activities like trail rides, swimming, crafts, nature study, fun and friendship.
